I. NAME

The purpose for which this corporation is organized is to provide for maintenance, preservation and architectural control of the Lots and Common Area within that certain parcel of real property described as:

according to plat thereof to be recorded in the public records of St.

Johns County, Florida, and any additions thereto (the "Property").

And to promote the health, safety and welfare of the residents within the above-described Property and any additions thereto as may hereafter be brought within the jurisdiction of this Association for such purpose.

All of that land contained within the plat of SPANISH OAKS,

In furtherance of such purpose, the Association shall have power to:

a. exercise all of the powers and privileges and to perform all of the duties and obligations of the Association as set forth in that certain Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions for Spanish Oaks ("the Declaration") as same may be amended from time to time.

assessments pursuant to the terms of the Declaration and pay all expenses in connection therewith and all office and other expenses incident to the conduct of the business of the Association, including without limitation all licenses, taxes or governmental charges levied or imposed against the Property of the Association and the expense of maintaining and repairing the surface water or stormwater management system described in subsection h.

c. acquire (by gift, purchase or otherwise), own, hold, improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease, transfer, dedicate for public use or otherwise dispose of real or personal property in connection with the affairs of the Association.

borrow money, and with the assent of two-thirds (2/3) of each class of members, mortgage, pledge, deed in trust, or hypothecate any or all of its

real or personal property as security for money borrowed or debts incurred.

e. dedicate, sell or transfer all or any part of the Common

Property to any public agency, authority, or utility for such purposes and subject to
such terms and conditions as may be agreed to by the members. No such dedication
or transfer shall be effective unless consent to in writing by two-thirds (2/3) of each
class of members.

f. participate in mergers and consolidations with other non-profit corporations organized for the same purposes and annex additional residential property and Common Area, provided that any such merger, consolidation or annexation shall have the assent of two-thirds (2/3) of each class of members unless

have and exercise any and all powers, rights and privileges which a corporation organized under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of

III. MEMBERSHIP

Every person or entity who is a record owner of a fee or undivided fee interest in any Lot (including contract sellers but excluding persons or entities holding title merely as security for performance of an obligation) which is subject to assessment by the Association shall be a member of the Association. Membership shall be appurtenant to and may not be separated from ownership of any lot which is subject to assessment by the Association.

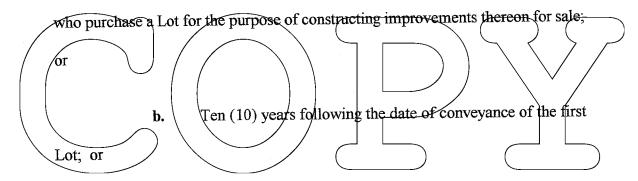
IV. CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP

Class A. Class A members shall be all Owners, with the exception of the Declarant (as defined in the Declaration). Each Owner shall be entitled to one vote for each Lot owned. When more than one person holds an interest in any lot, all such persons shall be members. The vote for such lot shall be exercised as they determine, but in no event shall more than one vote be cast with respect to any lot owned by a Class A member.

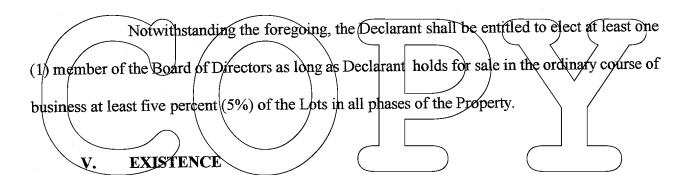
Class B. The Class B member(s) shall be the Declarant, who shall be entitled to six (6) votes for each lot owned. The Class B membership shall cease and be converted to Class A membership on the happening of either of the following events, whichever occurs first:

Three (3) months after ninety percent (90%) of all Lots in all phases of the Property that will ultimately be operated by the Association have been conveyed to members other than Declarant. For purposes of this section, the term

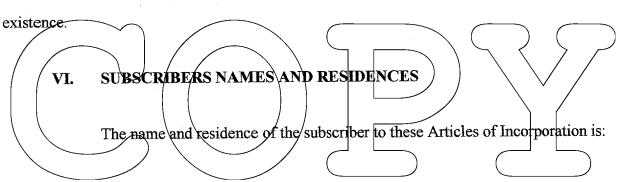
"members other than Declarant" shall not include builders, contractors, or others



c. At such time as the Declarant, in its sole discretion, elects to terminate the Class B membership.



Existence of the Association shall commence with the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of State, Tallahassee, Florida. The corporation shall have perpetual

The Board shall consist of no fewer than three (3) nor more than seven (7) members. The Directors shall be elected as provided in the By-Laws. After Class B membership ceases as provided in Article V of the Declaration, only owners of Lots may be Directors or officers. The Declarant may appoint or elect non-owners while Class B membership exists. The number of Directors may be changed by amendment of the Bylaws of the Association. less than two-thirds (2/3) of each class of members. Upon dissolution of the Association, other than

IX. AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Any amendment which alters the Surface Water or Stormwater Management System from its original condition must receive the approval of the St. Johns River Water Management District.

X. AMENDMENTS TO BYLAWS

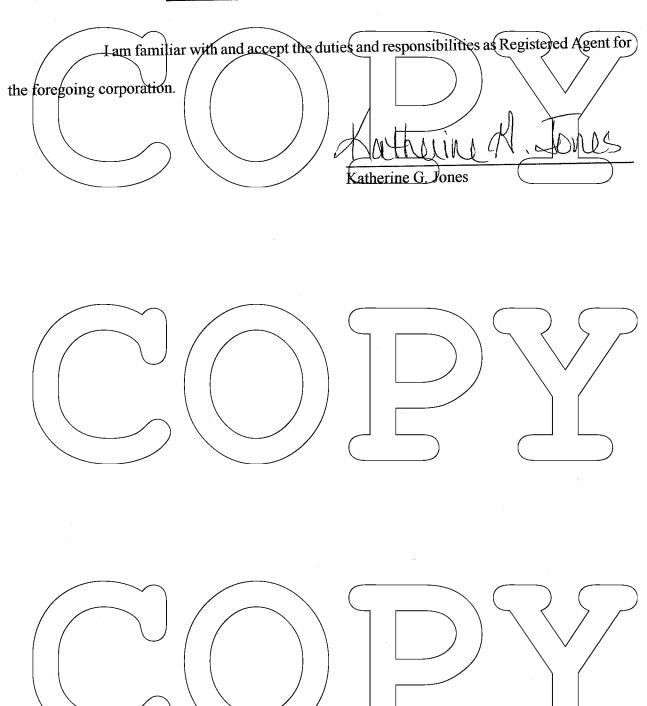
The Bylaws of the Association may be made, altered, or rescinded at any annual meeting of the Association, or at any special meeting duly called for such purpose, on the

affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of each class of members existing at the time of and present at such meeting by a person or by proxy, except that the initial Bylaws of the Association shall be made and adopted by the Board of Directors. INDEMNIFICATION XI. Every director and officer of the Association and every member of the Association serving the Association at its request shall be indemnified by the Association against all expenses and liabilities, including attorneys' fees and appellate attorneys' fees, reasonably incurred by or imposed upon him or her in connection with any proceeding or any settlement of any proceeding to which he or she may be a party, or in which he or she may become involved by reason of his or her being or having been a director or officer of the Association, or by reason of his or her serving of having served the Association at its request, whether or not he or she is a director or officer or is serving at the time the expenses or liabilities (are incurred;) provided, that in the event of a settlement before entry of judgment, and also when the person concerned is adjudged guilty of gross negligence or willful misconduct, indemnification shall apply only when the Board of Directors approves the settlement and/or reimbursement as being in the best interest of the Association. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition to and not in lieu of any and all other rights to which that person may be entitled.
